Hamworthy Engineering Co.Ltd.

One - Ruston-Hamworthy, Engine Driven Air Compressor Set  
Serial No. 464524.

This "Distair" Compressor set consists of a Ruston 2YWA, type, Air Cooled Diesel Engine which has had one cylinder replaced by a Hamworthy Air Cooled, Single Stage Air Compressor.

The compressor set has been constructed under special survey, in accordance with the approved plan and the Rules of the Society.

Material tests were carried out on the crankshaft and the connecting rods and the cylinder barrels and heads were tested hydraulically, all with satisfactory results.

On completion the above machinery was tried in the shops under working conditions with satisfactory results.
