Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "HUREX", and to the alterations recently effected to this vessel at Newcastle to fit her for burning liquid fuel, I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had the reports from the Society's Surveyors before them and with reference to the absence of sparring from the cofferdam bulkheads in way of cargo spaces above the level of the tween deck, I am directed to say that it is understood you do not intend to carry oil fuel in the cofferdam above the level of the tween deck.

If, however, it is intended to fill the cofferdam with oil fuel above the tween deck, it will be necessary to fit sparring to the top height of the cargo spaces, and the certificate of classification, enclosed herewith, is issued upon this understanding.
