Dear Sirs,

With reference to the letter dated the 13th June, 1957, addressed to you by the Society's Head Office in London, concerning the steamer "ARCHGROVE", and to your report No. 24166, which received the consideration of the Scottish Sub-Committee of Classification at their meeting yesterday, I have to state that, in view of your examination of the ship in drydock, as described on the reports in question, the Committee have agreed to the Special Survey being postponed until January, 1958, and have assigned, in the meantime, a docking date of DS 6,57 Pet. T.S. C.L. (n) 6,57, without special condition on the machinery.

As regards the hull, however, in view of the age of the ship and the fact that the Special Survey will be carried out within the next few months, it is not considered that the special condition attaching to the examination of the sternframe solepiece should be removed at this time.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.
