I am in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant respecting the Steamer "PHILADELPHIA", and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that the entry in the Special Reason List relating to the repair of the tank top plating of this vessel is in course of deletion. The rudder gudgeons, however, require to be examined at the next drydocking on account of electric welding repairs, and also the vessel was recently assigned the record of @LMC 7,22, subject to the donkey boiler not being used again, this boiler having been permanently blanked off at the Owners' request.
