"EMERALD"

New Boiler to be fitted next week.

"FELSPAR"

Vessel at present on the slip and screwshaft being drawn in.

"GIRASOL"

Boiler Survey to be held at next cleaning, when the 3rd. Special Survey No. 2 will probably be advanced or completed.

"CITRINE"

Boiler Survey to be held within the next three months.

"SARD"

Screwshaft to be drawn within the next three months.

"BERYL")

"SPINEL")

The surveys due on these vessels are being kept in view, but no definite arrangements can be made at present.
