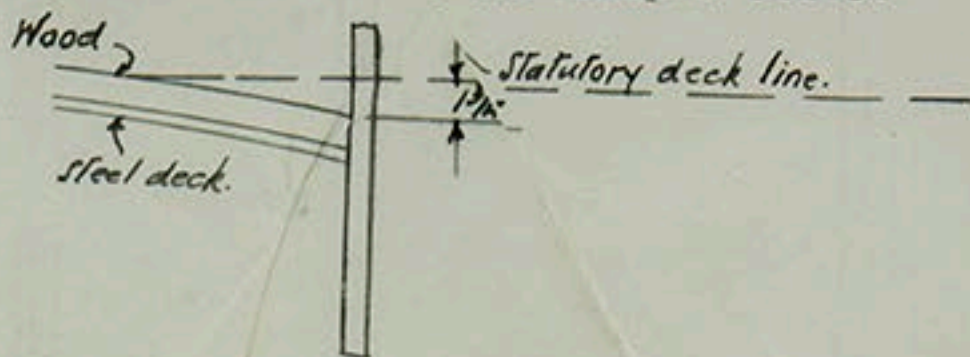

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of yesterday's date respecting the freeboard marking of the S.S. "DOMINICA" ex "DIGBY", and to acquaint you that your remarks have been noted.

With regard thereto I have to state that it would appear from your letter that the vessel will be running with more and not less freeboard than that assigned. This is partly due to an error in your method of setting off the statutory deck line, and partly due to the error regarding the wood deck; and I think it well to inform you for your future guidance that the statutory deck line should be set off as indicated in the following sketch, i.e. from the point where the wood deck intersects the ship's sides.
