Dear Sirs,

As arranged with your Mr. Harvey over the telephone to-day I have pleasure in forwarding herewith a memorandum setting forth the freeboards which have now been assigned to the S.S. "DOMINICA" ex "DIGBY". These freeboards have been assigned subject to the tonnage opening in the shelter deck being permanently closed or made into an upper deck hatchway, to the freeing ports and scuppers now led overboard from the 'tween decks being permanently closed with riveted plates and 'tween deck scuppers led to the bilges, and to there being no openings cut in the vessel's sides to affect the position of the load line disc.
