The Reservoirs have been built under Special Survey
in accordance with the approved plan and rules of the Society.

The Reservoirs were tested in the presence of the
undersigned on the 2nd March 1921 by hydraulic pressure to
550 lbs. per square inch, shewed no signs of weakness, and
were found sound and tight at that pressure. The working
pressure should not exceed Three Hundred and Fifty pounds per
square inch.
