Dear Sir,

Reverting to your letter of the 7th ultimo, with which you forwarded one from Messrs. T. & J. Brocklebank, Ltd. and to subsequent correspondence regarding the case of the s.s. "FULLAGAR", I am directed to say that the General Committee have had before them at their Meeting to-day a report, dated 31st ultimo, from Mr. A. Campbell Holms, the Principal Surveyor at your Port, upon the vessel, together with remarks submitted by the Chief Ship Surveyor on the case.

After very careful consideration of all the circumstances the Committee came to the conclusion that sufficient experience has not yet been gained of the application of electric welding to ship construction to justify the removal of the notations "Experimental" and "Subject to Annual Survey" from the record of the vessel in Lloyd's Register Book in this instance.

I shall be much obliged if you will kindly inform Messrs. Brocklebank accordingly.
