I am enclosing report No. 4029 covering the Special Survey No.3 and L. M. C., Tail Shaft and Donkey Boiler on the M. V. "CEDROS" ex "Shean".

I am also enclosing report No. C 11, two copies of the freeboard verification form and two copies of the provisional certificate, and returning a photostat of C 11 provisional received from the London office, also the original freeboard certificates for cancellation.

This vessel has been sold to Mexico, and will trade between Ensenada and Los Angeles.

The hull certificate is made out as before, subject to Biennial Survey, but in my opinion there does not appear to be any real reason for this, unless it is a standard practice with electrically welded ships.
