Dear Sir,

With reference to Glasgow First Entry Report No. 41720 on the Steamer "CONTE ROSSO", I have to acquaint you that it is concluded the topside plating is doubled at the ends of the erections as approved; that the thickness of the sheerstrake in way of the sidelights has been approved and that three hand pumps and two Downton pumps are fitted as shewn in the plan of pumping arrangements, but I shall be glad if you will kindly ascertain from the Surveyors and let me know if this is so.

At the same time I shall be glad to learn the water capacity of the double bottom tanks in way of the oil fuel bunkers if these may be used for ballast.

It is also concluded that the consent of the Owners has been obtained to the deviations from the Rules as required, but I shall be glad to hear from you on this point.

The classification certificates are enclosed herewith, as desired in your letter of the 28th ultimo, and should be handed to the Builders if the case is in order.
