With reference to Glasgow First Entry Report No.41720 being forwarded to-day on the Steamer "CONTE ROSSO", I beg to acquaint you that the Builders have asked to be supplied with the classification certificates in this case at the earliest possible moment. The fees have already been paid,

The Builders asked for the account for the fees to be sent to them some time ago and at that time the horse power was calculated to be 3724. It now, however, appears that the horse power is 3646, and the Builders have accordingly paid £1.19.0. too much for the survey of the machinery. It has been arranged that this payment shall be credited towards the fee due for the survey of the Refrigerating Machinery and I shall be obliged if you will kindly note this in your books.

The amount now outstanding for the survey of the Refrigerating Machinery is £2.1.0. due to Glasgow account and £2.10.9 due to London account.
