

Loeffler Boiler and Escher Wyss turbine installation.

IT IS SUBMITTED THE Winterthur Surveyor be informed the remarks contained in his letter of the 31st ultimo are noted, and that plans relating to the Escher Wyss turbines for this installation have not yet been submitted to this Office for consideration.

The Surveyor should inform the Firm of this fact and arrange for the necessary plans to be submitted, preferably through Messrs. Cantieri/^{Riuniti}del Adriatico and the Trieste Surveyors.

The Surveyor's remarks regarding the Germanischer Lloyd Surveyor are noted and Mr. Ormiston, the Principal Surveyor for Italy, is being asked to take this matter up with the Registro Italiano.

Meanwhile, the Surveyor should examine such parts as are presented to him for inspection without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER SUBMITTED the Trieste Surveyors be informed that the Winterthur Surveyor states that the forgings for the Escher Wyss turbines for this installation are already in the works of Messrs. Escher Wyss.

They should be reminded that plans of the turbines have not yet been submitted to this Office for consideration, and that having regard to the fact that the work is proceeding these plans should be submitted at an early date, as already requested in Secretary's letters of 5th April and 14th August 1935.

IT IS FURTHER SUBMITTED Mr. Ormiston, the Principal Surveyor for Italy, be informed regarding this case and that the Winterthur Surveyor states that Messrs. Escher Wyss have been requested to call in the Germanischer Lloyd Surveyor to act on behalf of the Registro Italiano in the examination of the turbines during manufacture at their Works.

Having regard to the terms of the agreement between the Registro Italiano and Lloyd's Register it is suggested that the Registro Italiano be reminded that the Society maintains a
