Dear Sir,

E. I am in receipt of your letter of the 20th instant, regarding the cast steel water regulator valve supplied by Messrs. Siemens-Schuckertwerke A.G., Berlin, and intended for the s.s. "CONTE ROSSO".

It is noted that the material for this valve was not tested by you, and, moreover, was not made at a Works recognised by this Society.

In all the circumstances it is not considered that this steel casting can be accepted by this Society, and the Society's Surveyors at Trieste are being informed accordingly.

I may add that in future cases of this nature, where the steel castings involved have not been made at recognised Works, it is desirable that you should first communicate with this Office before issuing any Certificate.
