I duly received your letter of the 13th instant, with enclosures advised therein relating to the above installation, and with reference thereto I have to inform you that the plan showing details of the manoeuvring steam valve will be approved, provided the valve be constructed and fitted under the usual conditions of survey and testing, and is found to function satisfactorily under working conditions.

It is concluded that the material of the stud bolts described as M.St.m.h. is a special steel having similar properties to the Ni. Cr. Mo. steel having a limiting creep stress of 22 Kg.mm² at 475°C, as described in my letter of the 20th September last to Messrs. Witkowitz.

With regard to the remaining contents of your letter, and the remarks of Messrs. Cantieri Riuniti dell' Adriatico, I shall be glad if you will inform the firm that the matters dealt with in the first three paragraphs of their communication are now in order.



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With regard to the Firm's enquiry concerning the feed pump turbine casings, I think it well to point out that this matter is dealt with in my letter to you, dated 12th instant, and the information requested therein is at present being awaited.
