Dear Sir,

In confirmation of my cablegram today regarding the case of the old tanker "CALLIROY" I can only say that the circumstances attending the ex Corvettes to which you refer were not analogous to this case as they were of much more recent construction and were to be towed to Holland for conversion to whale catchers and for submission to classification with this Society.

The Committee dislike being called upon to issue towage or provisional certificates for old ships not in class particularly when they are proceeding to a shipbreakers yard across the Atlantic, and today they adhered to their decision that we should not issue the certificate desired in this case.
