Copy letter received from Mr. Marey, dated 29th May, 1922.

Dear Dr. Montgomerie,

Your letter with enclosures regarding
the "SANTA MARIA" is hand.

I am extremely sorry that the note on
the approved plans appears to have been overlooked. I had no
idea but that all the requirements had been complied with.

Mr. Macleod dealt with the drawing Office, and the matter was never
referred to me. As you know, I took particular interest in these
vessels to see that the workmanship was satisfactory, in view of
previous trouble, but I took it for granted that the structural
arrangements were in order.

You may depend that in future cases, I
will pay particular attention to this requirement, and I have
written to Mr. Macleod regarding the matter.
