Dear Sir,

I enclose a copy of a letter which I have received from the Surveyors at Hamburg in connection with the motorship "DALKEY COAST" from which you will see that difficulty is being experienced in collecting the fees due to the Society.

A statement giving the sterling equivalent of these fees is enclosed.

I agree with the suggestion contained in the last two paragraphs on the first page of the letter and shall be glad if you will approach The Coastal Shipping Co., Ltd., and endeavour to obtain payment from them.

You may inform them that the Committee have decided to withhold assignment of class to the ship and consequently no notation of class will be made in the Register Book neither will the First Entry Certificates be issued until the fees are paid. You are aware that Section 24 of the Rules provides for this.

It is thought best that you should perhaps defer any consultation on the sister vessel at least until you have had the opportunity of reporting to me the results of your first meeting with the Owners on the subject of the "DALKEY COAST".

Perhaps you would also remind the Owners that payment has not yet been received in respect of an account for £5.10. 0 rendered to them on the 6th August from this office for the examination by the Hamburg Surveyors of repairs to the Steering Engine on 14th July last.
