We enclose a letter from Messrs. John Kelly, Ltd. and trust that you can meet the request contained therein.

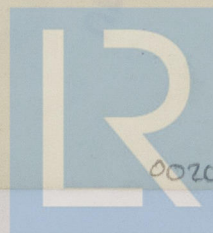
It is noted from our records that the ship was examined at Belfast in July, 1956 (Belfast Report No. 16162) and an Interim Certificate was issued for a voyage in ballast to Troon where she was to be broken up. It is noted that temporary repairs had been effected previously and were seen by the Liverpool Surveyors and it is assumed that these would have been carried out in April, 1956, following the grounding, as the ship lay in Belfast from April until July.
