3 sidelights with deadlights (P. & S.) fitted in Nos. 1, 2, 4 & 5 lower tween decks.

2 wood companionways fitted at each hatch, cleats, battens and tarpaulins amended
to suit new conditions.

10 air pipes (S.S.) extended to 33" & 36" high.
