I have your letter of the 29th ultimo respecting the steamer "AENOS" and note your remarks.

In the circumstances, provided the vessel is submitted to a satisfactory General Examination when she drydocks at Genoa about the end of this month, the Committee will be prepared to consider postponement of the Special Survey, but in view of her age the period of deferment must be dependent on the condition of the ship as then found and in any case should not exceed twelve months from the date of the General Examination.

At the same time special attention should be paid to the outstanding hull conditions of class i.e. shell plate in 3rd below sheer, etc. aft of engine room (port side) and shell plate No.2 (port and starboard) from aft in 5th strake below sheer being dealt with as necessary at the next Special Survey and to shell plating etc. in way of Nos.1 and 4 holds (port side) being further examined at the next dry docking.
