Further to our letter of the 5th January last regarding the examination of the propeller of the above vessel, you have no doubt received the report of your Surveyor at Madras who inspected the propeller on completion of discharge at that port and found same in order. He issued a seaworthiness certificate for the voyage to Genoa.

Unfortunately the ship has been delayed both at discharging and loading ports and she sailed from Vizagapatam only on the 28th instant. We make her due, therefore, at Genoa about the 28th March next and after discharge she will enter drydock about the 30th or 31st March for examination of the propeller, tailend shaft etc.

At the same time, the Boiler which will become due in April, will be completed.

As the Special Survey will become due in May next, it is the Owners intention to carry out the general examination of the ship for the purpose of obtaining an extension of time in which to complete the survey as usual.

We shall be glad therefore if you will instruct your surveyors at Genoa accordingly.
