1st Entry.

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee this report should be returned to the Hamburg Surveyors and they should be requested to state if they are correct in reporting the thickness of the centre girder top angles as .48" and the thickness of the flat plate keel butt straps as .7" and .64"; *in view of the requirements of the Rules* they should also state if the steel has been tested as required by the Rules and fill in, in the space provided in the report, the length of the double bottom tanks.
