SOURCE OF INFORMATION

DANIEL QUARE.—Wick Radio, Sept. 9.
—Following received from Seydisfjörður
Radio at 1 50 a.m., G.M.T., addressed
steam trawler Daniel Quare: Have re-
ceived your Mayday (distress signal)
ashore seven miles WNW. of Langanes
(rest jammed).

—Following received from British steam
trawler Daniel Quare, GZBK, at 1 59
a.m., G.M.T.: (Jammed) making no
water (jammed), list to starboard (rest
jammed).

—London, Sept. 9.—
British steam trawler Camilla reported
this morning: Have steamed 40 miles
to assistance of steam trawler Daniel
Quare, aground at Langanes. Attempted
to pull vessel off rocks but she was
badly holed, and attempt was given up.
Put five of her crew on board an Ice-
landic gunboat. Weather, strong south-
easterly wind, visibility poor. Am re-
turning to fishing grounds.

—Wick Radio, Sept. 9.
—Following received from British steam
trawler Hull City at 8 55 a.m., G.M.T.:
Have just been in communication with
trawler Daniel Quare. The operator is
now closing down and all her crew are
transferring to an Icelandic gunboat.

—Reykjavik, Sept. 9.—
British steam trawler Daniel Quare
reported ashore Skoruvik, Langanes, last
night. Vessels already at scene to assist.

—London, Sept. 9.—
The crew of the Grimsby trawler Daniel
Quare were rescued by an Icelandic gun-
boat to-day after the ship had been
wrecked off the north coast of Iceland
near Skoruvik. The skipper, George
Sleeth, radioed his owners that the
trawler was badly holed and that sal-
vage was unlikely. He said his crew of
19 are safe and uninjured. Two
Grimsby trawlers are standing by the
wrecked vessel, which was homeward
bound with a catch.—Exchange Tele-
graph Company.
