We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to carry out their usual survey on material required for use with the Turbo-Electric propulsion equipment for the United Fruit Co's vessel "La Marea". The fitting out of this vessel will be done at Messrs. Workman Clark's Yard, Belfast.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
