Babcock & Wilcox, Limited of Renfrew attend at their Works at Renfrew on the 30th May, 1929 and subsequent dates for the purpose of inspecting and testing steel steam and water drums, sections, muddrums and superheater boxes under Job No. 6/1251, to the order of Messrs. Workman, Clark (1928) Ltd., and intended for the S.S. "LA MARCA".

The steam and water drums, sections, muddrums and superheater boxes were tested by hydraulic pressure to 650 pounds per square inch and satisfactorily withstood the test.

Mechanical tests of steam drums, headers, muddrums and superheater boxes are in accordance with the Society's Rules.

Sample header and muddrum, door and bridges were subjected to crushing and bending tests and satisfactorily withstood the test.
