Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letters of the 28th ultimo and 4th instant regarding the equipment of the "HELLENIC PRINCE", I have to confirm the intimation given to Mr. Scully yesterday, that the equipment numeral for this ship, computed from the information available in this Office, is approximately 42025, letter "b†".

Accordingly the anchors proposed for this vessel can be approved provided satisfactory evidence exists of weights and tests, but the chain cable should be 2.6/16" diameter, or equivalent high tensile quality.

I have to add, however, that if difficulty is experienced in procuring chain of this diameter, it could be recommended to the Committee that the existing chain of 2.1/8" diameter be accepted as a temporary measure, but only for a very limited period.

The equipment of ropes should be in accordance with or equivalent to equipment letter "b†", Table 53 of the Rules.

The deferred reports, first entry and plans are returned herewith as requested.
