With reference to your letter of the 25th ultimo, regarding the survey of the above vessel, the contents of which has been given to the Owners representative and his Consulting Engineer, Mr. Millett (non-Exclusive B.C. Surveyor) and they complained that this vessel has already carried out a drilling survey. It was pointed out to them that this survey was carried out 2 years ago and that only part of the survey was then held, but, I understand that they are coming to the London Office to further discuss the matter.

I have been informed that the work for the completion of the survey and the completion of alterations for the conveyance of emigrants to Australia is to be put out to tender and owing to this the work will not in all probability be carried out in this area.

In these circumstances I anticipate that I shall be asked to issue a temporary freeboard certificate to enable her to proceed elsewhere and I shall be glad to know whether I am in order in doing this.
