With reference to my letter of yesterday's date, I have to inform you that the requirements for classification, as contained in the enclosed copy of endorsement, dated 11th October 1946, will have to be complied with in addition to the requirements of a Periodical Special Survey (D), including the drilling of the shell plating.

As regards the machinery all plans as required for classification of vessels not built under survey must be submitted for consideration, and you should confer with the Owners' Representative in regard to the production or preparation of such plans.

I enclose, for your guidance in the case, a report of survey which was held at Chatham in December 1946, together with five hull plans.
