Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in Gothenburg

In comparing the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard Rpt the following alterations, previously carried out on dates not stated, have been noticed.

1) companionways:

In addition to those indicated in the Rpt LL.4.C two companionway are fitted, one on each side of N°3 hatch on upper Dr. They are of steel strongly constructed, leading from upper to 2nd Dr and fitted with a steel W.T. door secured with 5 dogs capable of being worked from both sides, height of sill 420 mm. ✓ Compensation to be arranged on deck in way of these companionways not later than 10/51

2) Gangway, cargo and coaling ports on ship's sides

The port holes with steel covers mentioned in Rpt LL.4.C have been found arranged now as follows:

a) in tweendeck between 2nd & 3rd deck N°8 each side

(it appears that other holes were previously existing but are now permanently closed) ✓

b) in tweendeck between upper & 2nd deck N°4 holes each side

The cargo ports (dimensions as per Rpt LL.4.C) are 2 on the port side and 1 on the std side in tweendeck between upper & 2nd deck, also 1 on each side of bridge ✓

CAPABLE OF BEING CLOSED WATERTIGHT.

The following alterations have been now satisfactorily carried out

3) scuppers and sanitary discharges

The following sanitary discharges have been now added:

(discharging from 2nd deck and led overboard into tweendeck between 2nd & 3rd deck). N°3 on port and N°6 on std side all with two brass non return valves one at ship's side and the other always accessible under service conditions ✓

4) Closing appliances to superstructure Bldg openings

Opening to Bridge front Bldg permanently closed ✓

5) Hatchways

N°4 hatchway on upper Dr permanently closed (coamings removed) ✓

N°4 hatchway on Bridge deck made flush on deck and

fitted with a portable steel W.T. cover 8 m/m thick, sheathed

with wood 65 m/m thick, reinforced with 4 webs 2 m/m thick ship

8 A webs f.s.s. dimensions 4980 x 6100 m/m secured with 8 bolts diam 20 m/m

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6) sidescutches

All sidescutches in tweendeck between 2nd & 3rd deck,
except 16 on each side forward, permanently closed by
fitting plate plugs welded on ship side ✓

7) The markings on the ship's sides have been changed
from B.C to L.R ✓
