Dear Sirs,

s.s. "HOMELAND" ex "BRASIL". RMC.

I have to acquaint you that RMC classification reports relative to the above named vessel have now been received from the Genoa Surveyors and as a result the vessel will be eligible for the notation of Lloyd's RMC 5,51 "to maintain temp. 140°F with sea temp. 86°F max" when a satisfactory cooling down test has been carried out. For this test all four insulated chambers should be reduced simultaneously to a temperature of not less than 100°F.

It is understood that the Owners propose to carry out this test at your Port during the period 10th to 15th September and I shall therefore be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention.
