Dear Sirs,

Triple Screw Steamer "BRASIL" to be renamed
"HOMELAND"

I am in receipt of your letter of the 21st April, with enclosures, from which it is noted that the new Owners of the above vessel have requested classification of the refrigerating machinery and appliances with this Society.

Your remarks are noted and I have to acquaint you that Drawing No. 4549 showing details of the four chambers has been examined and will be approved provided the arrangements be as shown thereon and the remaining requirements of the Society's Rules for Refrigerating Machinery and Appliances be complied with so far as they are applicable.

The contents of the Data Sheet are also noted and with regard thereto I should point out that the total external exposed surface of insulating envelope should include all boundary surfaces of the refrigerated spaces, and similarly the deck edges exposed to external conditions should include all those which lead outside the refrigerated space, whether to atmosphere, other cargo spaces, machinery spaces, or hatch trunks, etc.

With further reference to the Data Sheet, the external tube surfaces of the Freon Condensers and Evaporators appear to be very small, and a sketch of these components showing the number, length and diameter of the tubes in each should be forwarded.

The survey for classification should be in accordance with Section 5 of the Rules and in view of the age of this installation it is considered essential that the Condensers and Evaporators should be tested as laid down in Section 6, Clauses 8(b) and (c).
