Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in _____

Alterations: Forecastle Head

Steel casing with hinged steel door operated from both sides fitted at the after end of the Forecastle Head and forecastle fitted out for crews accommodation.

Steel Casing $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick, 3 x 3 x $\frac{1}{4}$ " stiffeners spaced 2'6" apart secured to ground and deck head bars.

Steel Door $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick opening 5'6" x 24" sill 14".

Portlights 2 - 10" C.I. hinged portlights with hinged deadlights fitted port & starboard.

Native W.C. 2 bowls fitted, port aft, outside of accommodation. Steel casing not yet fitted.

3" soil pipe lead to 3" C.I. storm valve fitted below main deck, adequately protected.

Brass storm valve to be fitted on vessel's return to Shanghai in lieu of C.I. valve.
