F. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant regarding the steamer "J.F.V.", and in reply have to inform you that a remeasurement survey was carried out on this vessel at Wexford in February, 1933 but no report has been received at this Office respecting compliance with the conditions of assignment or the marking of the new freeboards.
