I have to inform you that it appears from a First Entry Report received from the Society's Surveyors at Glasgow that the twin screw motor vessel "GLENOGLE" which was built by Messrs. Harland & Wolff Ltd., Durban, has proceeded to your port.

To complete the Survey, the following work remains to be done:-

Deep tank to be tested and ceiling to be fitted on oil fuel tank between tunnels.

Damage on starboard side in way of fore peak requires to be dealt with.

I shall be glad if you will be so good as to give this matter the necessary attention and forward a Report on form 8 on completion of your Survey, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
