The New Twin Screw Motor Vessel "GLENOGLE", No. 59121 in the Register Book has left Glasgow for your Port and to complete the First Entry, the deep tank with the exception of the shell requires to be re-tested.

The Builders' - Messrs. Harland & Wolff, Ltd. - have sent workmen to Middlesbrough to complete the caulking of this tank and arrangements have been made that when it is ready for testing, one of their Assistant Managers will notify your Office.

The top plating of the oil fuel tank between the tunnels of this vessel has been increased in thickness under the hatchways and conforms to the Rule, the Owners' representative states, however, that he proposes to fit ceiling in way of the same at Middlesbrough.

Just before the vessel sailed from Glasgow, she sustained damage in way of the fore peak tank, starboard side, above the light water line when a shell plate was slightly indented, and afterwards drawn out and

to do this at Middlesbrough.

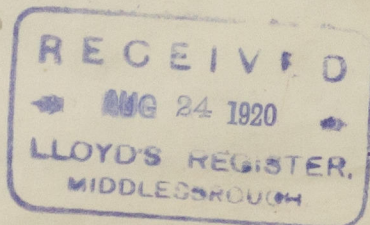
The Assistant Manager referred to has been in charge
