the summer freeboard allotted
to this steamer is '4½',

while her sister ships the Grenville,
Staldon and Hastor are each
allotted '4", if anything, we
consider the "Lynton" should have
a more favorable freeboard than the
three steamers named, for
the reason that her sheer is considerably
more and her bridge deck
and poop aft are longer
than in the vessel's named.
