I have to report that I have surveyed the Steam Tug
"SCHELDE" of Rotterdam O.N. -----
on this date.

I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition. The Special Survey has now been partly held and the vessel will be recommended to be continued as classed and to have notation for S.S.Rot.5-46 when the survey has been completed.

The original freeboard certificates have been transmitted to the Netherland Authorities and new certificates have been issued by them extending until the end of the year of grace allowed for the next Special Survey ultimo May 1951.


