I have to report that I have surveyed the Dutch tug  
"SCHELDE" of Rotterdam O.N.  
this date.

I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

The vessel has been transferred to the Dutch flag, name, Owners, etc. as before.

New freeboard certificates have been issued by the Dutch Authorities, valid until the end of the year of grace allowed for the next special survey, ultimo November, 1939.

The old French certificate is returned herewith.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate ~~by the French Authorities~~  
issued by the Dutch Authorities.
