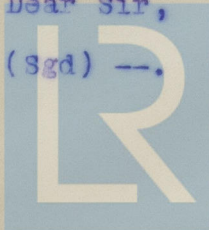
With reference to your letter of the 17th instant respecting the steamer "NORDLYS" we have to inform you that in reply to your letter of the 19th December we wrote you on the 23th December as follows:-

"In reply to your letter of the 19th instant respecting the steamer "NORDLYS" we have to inform you that the Owners state, that the vessel has been dry docked at Newport News in the days between the 9th and 24th instant, when the freeboard has probably been marked and verified, the master having been instructed to have it done.

"The Owners would be glad to be informed when you have received the information of it having been done".

We have again communicated with the Owners, who state that if the freeboard were not verified at Newport News as expected, but of which no statement has yet been had, it will be done at the first opportunity.
