We are in receipt of your advise-letter of the 20th ultimo together with the accompanying 4 plans of the motor vessel "PERU", but have not as yet received the plans concerning the machinery of the vessel, nor have the classification certificates come to hand.

Through the local newspapers we have learned that 24 mail-bags from England to this country have been lost or partly lost by destruction of the swedish mail steamer "Arthur".
