FLOODING ARRANGS.

Existing flooding valves removed.

New flooding valves fitted at this time in fwd. & after holds.

Valves of gunmetal, screw down type.

6" double valves fitted to steel inlet boxes at ship's side, fwd. hold (S.S. fwd.) and after hold (S.S. fwd.) with outlet pipes led to respective

spaces. Each valve controlled from freeboard ^{or rain quarter} deck with handwheel

fitted with OPEN/SHUT indicator. Handwheels contained in steel red painted boxes

seaming having steel cover plate secured with hasp and padlock

Keys for same are in the possession of the master.
