Dear Sir,

With reference to the Secretary's letter of the 1st July regarding Liverpool Report No.100648 on the steamer "LADY LEINSTER", I beg to inform you that the alterations required to conform to the International Load Line Convention have been carried out as follows:-

- (1) A steel door, in halves, capable of operation from both sides has been fitted to the companionway on forecastle deck.
- (2) The fiddley gratings are closed with steel plate covers which are efficiently secured.
- (3) Shifting boards have been fitted for half height at the openings at the after end of the bridge.
