Sir,

With reference to your letter of the dates quoted enclosing new freeboard computations for the undermentioned ships, I have to inform you that whilst the ships do not at present hold Passenger Certificates, it is considered the loadline certificates should be endorsed as follows:-

"When more than twelve passengers are carried the freeboard of the ship shall be governed by the terms of the Passenger and Safety Certificate".
