Dear Sir,

I am advised by the Society's Glasgow Office that the steamer "LADY CONNAUGHT" is being fitted out as a Hospital ship and that it has been decided to raise the freeboard deck to the superstructure deck by filling in the forward and after wells and fitting hinged steel doors in the ships side in place of the present gangway doors.

Amended freeboards have accordingly been computed and I enclose a copy of the computation and shall be glad to learn what endorsement will be required on the Load Line Certificate.
