Sir,

The Twin Screw "LADY CONNAUGHT" is being fitted out as a vital Ship. It has been decided to raise the freeboard deck to the structure deck by filling in the forward and aft wells and fitting steel doors in the ships' side in place of the present gangways. It will be noted there is a difference in height between the castle and bridge between decks.

I shall be glad to be informed what increase of draft may be needed and also the scantlings of shell, decks, etc., for the structure in the wells.

It is proposed to close the hatchways by plating them over with exception of the portions to be fitted as steel companionways.

I shall be glad to have a copy of the midship section and file for reference purposes.
