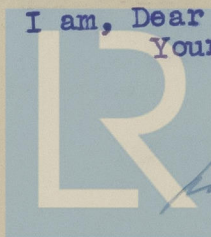
The memorandum forwarded with your letter of the 27th May is returned for cancellation.
