Dear Sir,

I have to enclose a copy of a letter, dated the 20th instant, which has been received from Messrs. Bibby Bros. & Co., Liverpool, regarding the S.S. "LANCASHIRE" and have to state that the present freeboard certificate gives the Summer Freeboard as 9'1" for which equivalent draft is 26'9". It is understood that the draft of 23'6" is that obtained with a Summer Freeboard of 11'1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " in accordance with the 1940/41 edition of the Register Book, plus 1'2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " when more than 12 passengers are carried.

The vessel is at present under survey at this port and is expected to complete the Special Survey early in July next when the Freeboard Renewal Survey will also be completed and new Loadline Certificates applied for.

The deferred reports are sent herewith for reference and I shall be glad if you will be good enough to return them in due course.
