Dear Sir,

I beg herewith to forward you the reports of surveys for freeboard for the steamers "ARCTURUS", "ARGO" "LAPPONIA" and "TARMO" and also the freeboard verification forms for the "NAVIGATOR" and "INGA".

With reference to your letter of the 26th August regarding s.s. "INGA" I also enclose particulars of the superstructures and casings and beg to inform you that your assumptions regarding the bridge bulkheads and regarding the penings in poop and the bridge bulkheads are correct.

I have recommended that the bearing surface for the hatch covers on s.s. "INGA" are to be renewed within months from this date as these have been damaged by the cargo. Suitable provisions for rigging lifelines have been ordered on s.s. "NAVIGATOR" and "INGA".

As s.s. "ARCTURUS" is at present lying in dry dock here, I beg you kindly to forward me the freeboard computation as quickly as possible.
