This ship was examined afloat by the LONDON Surveyors (11,53) on account of damage stated sustained as the result of an explosion in the auxiliary lighting accumulator compartment and slight indentation of aft end of E.R. light and air casing also slight distortion of the boat deck plating reported.

Owing to the minor nature of the damage no recommendations were made.

The scantlings and arrangements, as reported, conform with the Society's Revised Rules and Regulations, and are in accordance with or equivalent to those shown on the approved plans.
